HMOs generally require members to select a primary care provider (PCP) to coordinate care and if you need a specialist, the PCP will choose one who is also in our network.

Our plans give you access to our network of highly skilled medical providers in your area. You can look forward to choosing a primary care provider (PCP) to work with you and coordinate your care. You won't pay more than \$35 for up to a one-month supply, \$70 for up to a two-month supply or \$105 for up to a three-month supply of each covered insulin product regardless of the cost-sharing tier, even if you have not paid your deductible (if your plan has a deductible).

- Review the pharmacy directory to make sure the pharmacy you use for any prescription medicine is in the network. If the pharmacy is not listed, you will likely have to select a new pharmacy for your prescriptions.

Understanding Important Rules

- □ In addition to your monthly plan premium, you must continue to pay your Medicare Part B premium. This premium is normally taken out of your Social Security check each month.
- □ Benefits, premiums and/or copayments/co-insurance may change on January 1, 2025.

If you are currently enrolled in a Medicare Advantage plan, your current Medicare Advantage healthcare coverage will end once your new Medicare Advantage coverage starts. If you have a Medigap plan, once your Medicare Advantage coverage starts, you may want to drop your Medigap policy because you will be paying for coverage you cannot use.
