Who can use this form?

People with Medicare who want to join a Medicare Advantage Plan.

To join a plan, you must:

- ☐ Be a United States citizen or be lawfully present in the U.S.
- ☐ Live in the plan's service area

Important: To join a Medicare Advantage Plan, you must also have both:

- ☐ Medicare Part A (Hospital Insurance)
- ☐ Medicare Part B (Medical Insurance)

When do I use this form?

You can join a plan:

- ☐ Between October 15-December 7 each year (for coverage starting January 1)
- ☐ Within 3 months of first getting Medicare
- ☐ In certain situations where you're allowed to join or switch plans
